



NORTH STATE FOOTBALL OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The selection process would be as follows:

1. The scholarships are limited to football players and/or team members including managers, statisticians, trainers, cheerleaders, etc.
2. Each school will be limited to one applicant each year and that applicant must be a senior.
3. Each school will handle its own process of nomination. The head coach should select an applicant and take the name to the Athletic Director or Principal. If they concur on the applicant, an application form should be completed by the applicant and mailed before the deadline.
4. After receiving all applications and sorting them by regions, the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee will then call a meeting of his committee to select winners from each of the three regions.
5. The \$1,000.00 scholarship is a one-time amount for the individual. It is not renewable.
6. The check will be written to the college where the recipient is attending. However, if this would cause any possible violation of the N.C.A.A., N.A.I.A. or other similar organizations, the Committee would then look at other ways of awarding the scholarship to the scholarship recipient. NOTE: A recipient can forfeit or return the scholarship money to the North State. If this happens, the Committee could award the scholarship to someone else who is eligible and in that region. NOTE: It is recommended if a recipient has received a full scholarship that the coach nominates another player for the North State Scholarship.
7. The scholarship would be awarded to the individual upon furnishing the North State with a letter stating his/her enrollment in a college of his/her choice. This would normally occur in August. However, if the recipient notifies in writing and verification from the college that he/she will be a student the second quarter or semester, the Committee may then hold the money until second semester.
8. All scholarship monies will be disbursed in the fiscal year they are due. If there are any appeals concerning money disbursements, they will be held until the governing body approves or disapproves.
9. The scholarships are not awarded solely on academic, need, abilities, personalities, etc. NOTE: All factors should be considered.
10. The applicant should be willing to represent himself/herself and his/her school (team).

11. The applicant should possess characteristics such as: (a) sportsmanship, (b) strong character, (c) academic record, (d) leadership, (e) ability as a player or member of the team, (f) activities in school, (g) activities in the community. Applicant should write to the Selection Committee at least one page, but not more than two pages hand written or typed about himself/herself.
12. Two letters of recommendation should accompany the application. The letters should be from (a) the applicant's coach and (b) a principal or faculty member.
